WHAT IS GEOCACHING?

Geocaching is the ultimate treasure hunt.

A geocacher can locate a cache location using GPS technology and then share the cache and location online. Anyone with a GPS device can try to locate a geocache.

WHAT'S USUALLY IN A CACHE?

A cache always contains a logbook or logsheet for you to log your find. Larger caches may contain a logbook and any number of items. These items turn the adventure into a true treasure hunt. You never know what the cache owner or visitors to the cache may have left for you to enjoy. Remember, if you take something, leave something of equal or greater value in return.

GEOCACHING IN 8 SIMPLE STEPS

- Go to www.geocaching.com and register for a free account.
- Click "Hide and Seek" a Cache.
- Enter a Postal Code or address and search "Shelburne County GeoTrail Adventure" for a list of all the caches.
- Choose any geocache from the list and click on its name.
- Enter the coordinates of the geocache into your GPS Device.
- Use your GPS device to help you find the hidden geocache.
- Sign the logbook and record the code in your cacheport and return the geocache to its original location.






